- Submit an official high school transcript with the Registrar's seal.
- Submit SAT/ACT scores

The Scholarship Recipient:

Will be the highest scoring applicant based on scoring guide determined by Delta Beta Chapter

- Must major in Education
- Must submit document from college or university verifying proof of enrollment
- Will receive \$3000 (first year only) awarded in increments of \$1500. \$1500 Fall semester, then \$1500 in the Spring semester, provided the recipient maintains a minimum grade point average of 2.5 while pursuing a degree in the field of education.

Any recipient who **does not** adhere to the Rules, Regulations and Eligibility Requirements will be disqualified.
